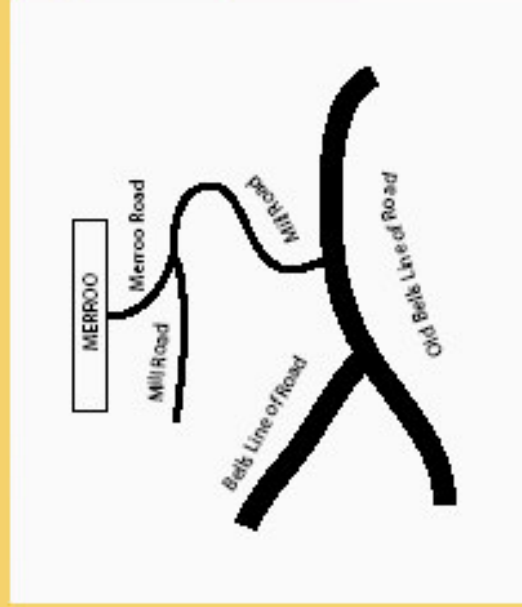

## *How to get there...*

Head along the M2 to Windsor then follow the signs to Kurrajong. Take Kurrajong Rd which becomes Bells Line of Road. Turn right off Bells Line of Road onto Mill Rd, then right again onto Merroo Rd. The conference Centre is at the end of the road.

OR

Take the M1. Turn off at Penrith and follow the signs to Windsor. From Windsor follow directions to Kurrajong. Take Kurrajong Rc, which becomes Bells Line of Road. Turn right off Bells Line of Road onto Mill Rd, then right again onto Merroo Rd. The conference Centre is at the end of the road.
